Data categories, purposes and legal basis of the processing

We process your personal data that we receive from you or third parties due to business relations. These are usually contact data (name, address, telephone number and e-mail address) and - as far as necessary within the framework of the business transaction - bank and payment data (bank, account details, reason for payment, credit card information if applicable), information from publicly available sources, info databases and credit agencies (e.g. Internet, commercial register, credit agency) as well as other data which you voluntarily provide us with within the framework of the processing of a project or a contractual relationship or within the framework of a contract initiation.

We process your personal data exclusively within the framework of the statutory regulations, in compliance with the regulations of the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) and the EU Data Protection Adjustment and Implementation Act (Federal Data Protection Act, new).

The processing is carried out based on the legal regulations described below and for the following purposes

- the initiation, implementation and conclusion of contracts
- (Art. 6 para. 1 b GDPR), e.g. performance of a contract (e.g. delivery or provision of a service and handling of payments), general communication with business partners, (e.g. answering enquiries about products and services, contract negotiations etc.)
- based on given agreements (Art. 6 para. 1 a GDPR), e.g. sending newsletters or information letters, participation in marketing campaigns or surveys etc;
- based on legal requirements (Art. 6 Para. 1 c GDPR), e.g. to fulfil or fiscal retention obligations to fulfil reporting or information obligations to authorities, etc;
- based on a legitimate interest (Art. 6 Para. 1 f GDPR); e.g. measures for IT security or measures to ensure proper business operations, to safeguard domiciliary rights, to assert legal claims or to defend in legal disputes, to ensure compliance requirements,

Recipients or categories of recipients of personal data

We transmit your personal data to authorities/public bodies if required by overriding legal regulations.

For various business transactions we also use external service providers as contract processors in the sense of Art. 28 GDPR. Data processing contracts have been concluded with these service providers to ensure the protection of your personal data.

The recipients described above are generally located within the European Economic Area. If at any time a transfer to a third country should become necessary, we will ensure that this transfer only takes place in accordance with the legal regulations (Chapter V GDPR). 3

Data storage period

Usually, personal data is deleted after the legally prescribed retention periods have expired. If the personal data is not affected by these retention obligations, it is deleted when it is no longer required for the purposes described above. A different retention period may apply if you have consented to this when the data was collected.

Rights concerned

You have the right to receive information about your personal data stored by us, to have incorrectly stored personal data corrected or - if relevant - to change or revoke your consent to data processing at any time, even without stating reasons, with effect for the future, to have the processing of your personal data restricted with effect for the future, or to object to the processing or demand the deletion of your personal data. You are entitled, under the conditions laid down in Art. 20 GDPR, to receive the personal data relating to you that has been stored in a structured, common and machine-readable format and to transfer this data to another person responsible without hindrance from us.

Right to appeal

You have the right to complain about the processing of personal data by us at supervisory authority for data protection.

Data protection officer
